Town Council Town Manager Candidate Interview Minutes

August 5, 2011

CALL TO ORDER:

Present were Mayor Gary Bruhn, Council Members Richard Irwin, Norma Sutton, Molly Rose, Jim O'Brien and Mike Pirozzolo. Town Clerk Dorothy Burkhalter was also present. Members of the public were also present.


General discussion began at 6:16pm. Mayor Bruhn led everyone in the pledge of allegiance.


1. Candidate Interview – Greg Dunham

Mayor Bruhn began the interview at 6:30pm. He then introduced each Council Member to Mr. Greg Dunham. Mayor Bruhn asked Mr. Dunham for a brief background summary of himself. Mr. Dunham commented on his personal and professional background. Member O'Brien then explained the interview process. He then stated that Member Pirozzolo will begin the interview with the first question. Each Council Member and the Mayor asked questions of Mr. Dunham in a round table forum. After discussion was made, Mayor Bruhn advised the candidate that the item will be discussed at the next town council meeting. The candidate's interview completed at 8:10pm.

Review of all interview candidates began. Each candidate's pros and cons were discussed. Member O'Brien stated that he would put Mr. Lombardi as number two. Others agreed.
