 - Discussion and approval of terms of members:

 - The terms of the initial members shall be staggered so that approximately 2 members serve a 3 year term, 2 members serve a 2-year term, and the remaining members shall serve a 1 year term.
 - All appointments thereafter shall be for 3 year terms.
