


Municode Mobile Online Codes


From a Smart Phone, or Tablet with full internet access start at our main page by navigating to www.municode.com and then select the Code Library tab at the top. There is nothing for you to download, or sign up for.

Once you have selected a state, then choose which City or County online Code to view. You can choose by clicking on the name of the City or County.

After selecting the City or County, click on “View Mobile Version”.

The options may be a little different for each different Client’s code. But, it’s pretty straight forward from here. You can navigate through the code, run searches using the search box at the top, or click on the “Standard Site” link to navigate to the full version of the online code. The “Standard Site” link would be best used only if you are using a tablet, or device with a larger screen size than a smart phone.
