

Hello Diane,

Would you please add my December event notes to the January agenda? Thank you!

December Event Notes:

Attendance: great

Weather: warm and as the night wore on, got comfortable

Truck behavior: Parking was easy

No-Shows:

1. Manna - no call no show

- 2. 900 Degreez called out at 1:30pm. Sick wife. Did not find a replacement.
- 3. La Empanada new owners recently bought the truck this Fall. They dropped out of all December Bazaar events. They were scheduled for December at Windermere but they said they did not understand they were responsible for finding their own replacements even though this was explained.
- 4. El Cactus Azul called out a few days before the event. Did not find a replacement.

Problems:

Adao Empanada:

- 1. It's a handmade product
- 2. It's a decent/fair price
- 3. The owners are very professional
- 4. But...
- 5. Average wait time 40 minutes for 3 empanadas according to the guests I spoke with. Owner says he averages 35 minutes. Employees at windows are telling the guests 30 minute wait time.

Box on the road:

- 1. This truck detracted from guests' enjoyment of the event. I do not recommend welcoming this truck again until they create systems for (1) speed and (2) cooking continuity for guests.
- 2. Woman employee touching raw meat with her hands: a full set of five or six raw hicken skewers.
- 3. Witnessed employee putting raw chicken over cooked and cooking meats (chicken and beef)
- 4. Underage child (around 5?) in the open back porch back of the truck sitting on a table.

- 5. Slow Average wait was 30-40 minutes. I spoke with several guests waiting in line. They appeared disappointed and confused as to why it was taking so long.
- 6. Witnessed raw sausage given to guest. He returned it. Told me he waited a total of one hour including the first time to wait for the raw sausages and then again to wait for them to cook him fresh ones.
- 7. Witnessed that a guest had been given raw chicken. Received refund.
- 8. Using non commercial grade grills. They do not appear to cook at the speed needed for a commercial operation.
