I would like to bring this issue to your attention because I believe we have been served an injustice.

For the last 6 years we have attended the Food Truck events at Windermere. The number of guests we have served at each event has always been between 80-150 maybe more. We have many returning guests at this event.

We have worked extremely hard for 10 years to achieve a good reputation. The last 3 years we have contracts with Nasa and Disney.

I submitted my schedule to Mr. Baratelli for the next 3 months which includes Windermere and when it came back

i had no work with Bazaar or Windermere. I was shocked. I had no communication from Mr. Baratelli to explain why i had nothing scheduled. I knew i would see him at Windermere in March. I waited until the end of the evening to see if he would speak to me. I had to text and ask him to come to my trailer. When we spoke, i asked him why i was not on the schedule he said he would not speak to me about Bazaar so i said what about Windermere. He said my food was not quality and there are better trucks out there and he has to look after Windermere and get them the best trucks. I agree, but we are a good truck and i was extremely insulted. That evening at Windermere we took over \$1400 we sold 82 fish. We had returning customers. I did ask Mr. Baratelli to give me some indication why my food is suddenly not quality as nothing has changed, he could not give me an answer. Instead he sent Mr. Brian Connors and he said he would explain why we were not being invited to Windermere. He said I did not wear a hat, i had a hat on. He went on to say:

I double dip my chips, he is not even a cook and accusing me of a well known practice by chefs to get them crispy. It all seemed petty and unwarranted. A very nice Windermere resident was eating our fish at our table and was listening to Mr. Connor and he intervened and said why are you barracking a perfectly good truck. He said he lived next door to the Mayor.

Saturday morning Mr. Barratelli called me and said he had an error in judgement, i admit i was extremely upset and found it hard to talk to him.

I do not like to complain so i waited to see if Mr. Baratelli would reschedule us at Windermere he has not and this is why i have

come to you. I do not like people being able to try to ruin a reputation and lose them work on speculation and untruth. This is very important to me and my family.

Tamale Co drove away at 9:20. They didn't shut their windows at 9:30. They drove away. When I approached them they told me their boss told them the event ended at 9pm. I don't believe them. The female employee was rude.

Chicken Bites - They showed up around 15 minutes before the event began. They got shut down by the health department for not having Operating water. According to food truck owner Jeff with SMAC, this is a very big deal.

A woman passed out. I didn't witness it. Police cars and fire trucks were here before I knew it even happened.






