August Food truck night review:

Attendance was a decent windermere night. Not huge and crushing, but decent.

Trucks left a substantial amount of their own tied up garbage bags next to the garbage cans. A city employee told me.

SOLUTION 1 + 2:

(1) Do not allow city employees to leave tied up bags of trash next to a city garbage can. This is a visual cue to truck owners that they can leave their trash at the trash cans because the truck owners do not know that the bags the city employee are leaving next to the cans are city owned bags.

(2) The city employee told me that at the end of the night, as he is driving his pick up truck through the closed event, truck owners are asking him if they can throw their trash in the bed of his truck. He is saying yes. This needs to stop.

How can you empower the city employees to *not* leave their own tied up bags of trash next to the city owned cans after they empty the cans while *not* being forced to drive one bag of trash back and forth from each can to the dumpster?

Weather was sweaty and hot when it began.

The DJ is good for families. Can he come every month?

The wine store asked me how we can get more people to show up. My thought is this: the city is collecting \$150/truck. Surely at least social media advertising can be purchased using a portion of these funds.

Question - Can golf carts park on grass on public property? I got asked that question by a guest and don't know the answer.

nl Vendor is required to provide a trash can with a lid. Removal of trash and clean up in your area is required; even if it is not yours.

nl Arrival time is 3:00pm. Set-up must wait until all trucks are in place. Trucks will stage in designated area prior to entering event space.

nl Vendor is to provide their own power supply that will connect to the Town's electrical supply. All power cords that are in the service area must be secured to the ground to avoid accidents per Florida State Law. The Town of Windermere does supply an adapter for \$100.



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1. Vendor must identify the amount of amperage needed to run the Truck during the event. Please review the attachment for the appropriate plug and amp size. We also have a 20 amp that utilizes the standard 3 prong plug.

2. Vendor is required to hook up to the Town's electrical outlets. No generators will be allowed.

3. Should a Vendor show up without the appropriate hookups or is unable to connect to the Town's power supply, they will be asked to leave the event, if prior to 4:30pm. Should this occur after 4:30pm, the Vendor will need to close down their Truck and not allow service. They will not be allowed to remove their Truck until after the event has ended.

4. Service time is from 5:00pm until 9:30pm. NO EXCEPTIONS!

5. Arrival time is 3:00pm. Set-up must wait until all trucks are in place. Trucks will stage in designated area prior to entering event space.

6. Each truck should be prepared to serve approximately 250-300 people. Packing and cleaning up is permitted if you sell out prior to 9:30pm. Your truck must remain lit and accessible to optimize a professional look.

7. Each vendor must collect 6.5% on all taxable sales.

8. The Town of Windermere reserves the right to alter scheduled dates, rotations, Truck participation, and Truck availability based on cuisine, amperage, and conduct of participants.

9. If your truck is scheduled for a Town of Windermere Food Truck Night event, and cannot attend for any reason, it is the vendor's responsibility to find a suitable replacement. The Event Manager, Mark Baratelli (mark@thedailycity.com 407-308-1417), will provide you with a contact list. This list can be used to send an all-call email to every approved Truck, requesting a replacement. When a replacement is found, the original Truck will call, text, or email Mark for final approval. The replacement Truck must be cleared by Mark (*some replacements may not be approved for various reasons, ex: If the replacement truck serves lobster, and another lobster truck is already scheduled, the replacement truck will not be approved*), **AND** must be a Windermere-approved truck.

10. If a truck is scheduled for a Windermere Food Truck Night Event, and fails to show up, or does not find a suitable replacement, that truck forfeits their \$150 fee to the Town of Windermere.



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PL Vendor shall indemnify and hold the Town of Windermere, its employees, agents, officials, and contractors, harmless from and against any and all claims; including, without limitation to, attorney's fees (whether incurred before during, or after trial, or upon appellate level) arising from the Vendor's participation in event.

PL Each Truck is responsible for knowing and adhering to the rules set forth in this agreement. Parking is available on a first come-first serve basis. **NO PARKING IS ASSIGNED.**

The process after receiving an invite to a specific event date (after being selected by the Selection Committee) is as follows:

- Once your truck has been approved by the committee, Diane Edwards will contact you for any missing information such as liability insurance or Credit Card Authorization Forms.
- Truck Approval lists are updated monthly after each selection meeting and an availability sheet will be sent out to each new truck during the months of December, March, June, and September. Once the form is completed please return to Mark Baratelli via email.
- Schedules are created on a QUARTERLY basis (every three months). **Trucks can expect to be invited to an event zero to one event per quarter due to the high volume of trucks approved by the Town of Windermere Selection Committee.**

Upon failure to do so the business shall be subject to the payment of another business tax for the same business or profession.

• **RENEW THIS TAX BEFORE IT EXPIRES:** Pursuant to Florida Statutes, all Business Tax Receipts shall be issued by the Tax Collector beginning July 1st of each year, and it shall expire on September 30th of the succeeding year. Those Business Tax Receipts issued as renewal accounts beginning October 1st shall be delinquent and subject to a delinquency penalty of 10% for the month of October, plus an additional 5% penalty for each month of delinquency thereafter until paid; provided that the total penalty shall not exceed 25% of the business tax for the delinquent establishment (Florida Statute [FS] 205.053 [1]).

A 25% penalty shall be imposed on any individual engaged in any new business or profession without first obtaining a Seminole County Business Tax receipt ([FS] 205.053 [2]).

This Business Tax Receipt is only a receipt for business taxes paid. It does not permit the taxpayer to violate any existing regulatory or zoning laws of the state, county, or municipality, nor does it exempt the taxpayer from any other required licenses, registrations, certifications, or permits. Business Tax requirements are subject to legislative change.

• **REPORT ALL CHANGES:** The holder of this Business Tax Receipt is required to report a change in the following: Ownership, Business Location, Mailing Address, or any other information that would alter the status of the current year's information. This includes, but is not limited to, the loss of or a change in a State or Regulatory License which was used to qualify for the business identified on the current County Business Tax Receipt.
