1. Tornado warning machine went off at 8:07pm. Very loud. Everyone ignored it. Would be good to use this to announce the arrival of Santa Claus.
2. Grandmas BBQ claimed a child had to be picked up and needed to leave as soon as they sold out. So they left prior to the event ending.
3. Monsta Lobsta sold out at 8pm.
4. I chose to let the marshmallow truck take orders ten minutes after 9:30 due to the event having a larger attendance. I got approval from an officer and, I believe, the Chief of police.
5. We need more restrooms for this November date. We had 4 total. I'd say we need 6-8.
6. The November event needs 3 more trucks to handle the huge crowd. The lines were too long to be appropriate.
7. Idea: Rent the fancy restrooms on wheels. This is windermere. Even downtown Orlando is paying for the fancy rental bathrooms (see attached) during a year long trial program. We are being out-fancied by Orlando. LOL.
8. Idea: Every month we need an outside organization to participate in the event. The churches brought the November crowd. The touch a truck and police brought the October crowd. Can the town brainstorm an organization for each month of the year?
9. Arajace had so many outages that Tacos Mazatlan next door let them use their generator for the remainder of the night.

I got photos of the plug attachment all trucks need to buy. I'm going to send it to the trucks. I think the Town should consider doing the same and adding the photo to the application. It's attached to this email.

Light drizzle til 6pm.

7pm - Terrible turnout. Dead. So sad because the weather is so cool and comfortable.

8:20pm - medium rain started and didn't stop.

Around 8:45pm I decided to end the event. There were no more than 20 people present at the event. Around 3 trucks had customers. I spoke with the police and the clean up crew prior to making the call.

We now have 3 pizza trucks: Rollin' Dough, Wandèring Goat, and 900 Degreeez. The town needs to decide if we continue to have 900 at every event or spread it out evenly amongst the 3 trucks. The goal for having 900 there every month if I remember was to have a kid friendly truck there each month and to have a good looking and popular truck there each month. The other two Truck's, whole not as attractive, are not ugly. And they serve the popular pizza product.

Load in was smooth.

Diane - Could you alter your monthly email to trucks to reflect this - trucks cannot park before 3pm. If they park before 3pm they will be noted and we will stop scheduling trucks who do this - or some sort of punishment allowable by the Town. The language right now implies trucks should show up *by* 3pm, or that's my interpretation of the language.

The Melting Box didn't have the correct plug.

Please take a color photo of the adaptor and add the color photo to the Application. The diagram we are providing the truck owners doesn't make it explicit the type of plug they require. The plug we require has one of the tips bent in a way that is different and the drawing doesn't quite communicate that.

Idea: As part of the application process, make every new applying truck send you a photo of their purchased adaptor with receipt proving the trucks own what the City requires prior to the truck being approved. Or, once their approved, make them send you this afterwards. Keep it on file.

Idea: make all current trucks send you a photo of their adaptor and/or correct plugs. Trucks that don't do this within a reasonable time can't be scheduled for the following quarter.

Why put a food event the day after a food event? We want both events to succeed. Put the annual event two weeks before or after the monthly event.

A man came up to me prior to the event start time and wanted to sell glow in the dark light up toys to kids during the event. I said no. He said police let him set up on Town property across from the event recently. Is vending allowed on town property without some sort of permit? He also said he paid the ice cream store one month to set up in the sidewalk in front of the ice cream store.

We need a band every month. This is a large scale event. We need to improve this event.

If you're going to take the Xmas lights down the event will become dark. Consider hanging cafe lights from tree bough to tree bough to give some life and light to the event.

Oishimotto has a rice cooke or hot pot sitting on a folding chair. It looks terrible.

Jour de Crepe blew power FOUR times according to Travis. He says they are drawing too much power for a 20 amp circuit. They need to be told they are no longer allowed to be at a 20 amp plug. This occurred throughout the event even towards the end per Travis.

This whole area behind the white building is dark and creepy. Can we have some lights back here and not just one giant glaring balloon light not put too high above eye level.

Why is there not a playground on this property? Children are running around screaming all over the place. They need a place to gather and play.

Are people under 18 allowed to be here without a parent? It appeared there were more kids than adults tonight. I think this may be a drop off point for parents.

Can we get "no skateboards, bikes, scooters" signs and ban them from this event? They're rolling through the event. I've had multiple reports from police officers telling me this.

Tamale Co was a no call no show.

Don't allow trucks to use the dumpster and please tell Brian and his wonderful team to not suggest it to trucks anymore. 17 trucks worth of trash will fill up and overflow that dumpster. Also, it will be an eyesore watching truck owners and employees hauling trash throughout the event.

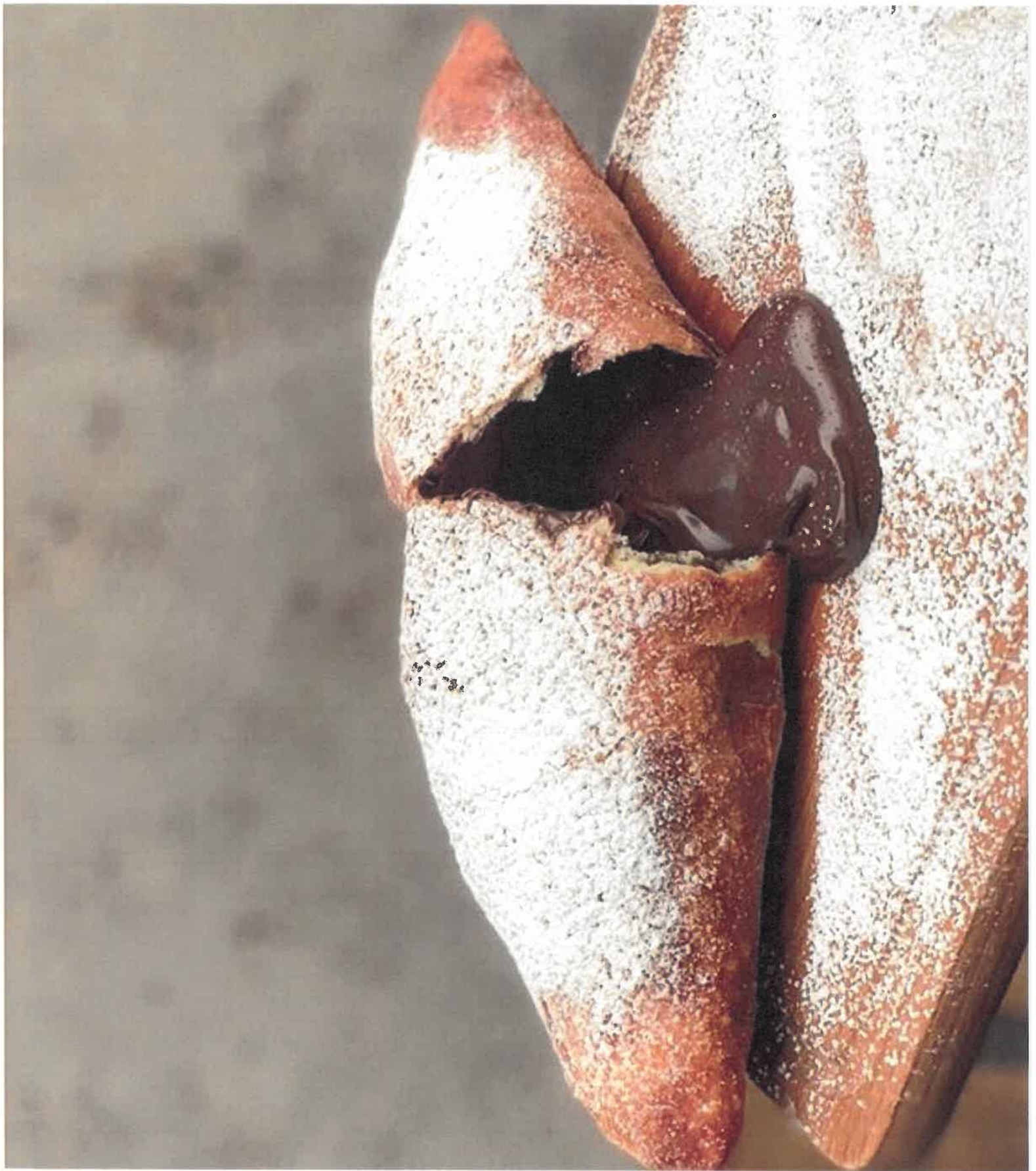

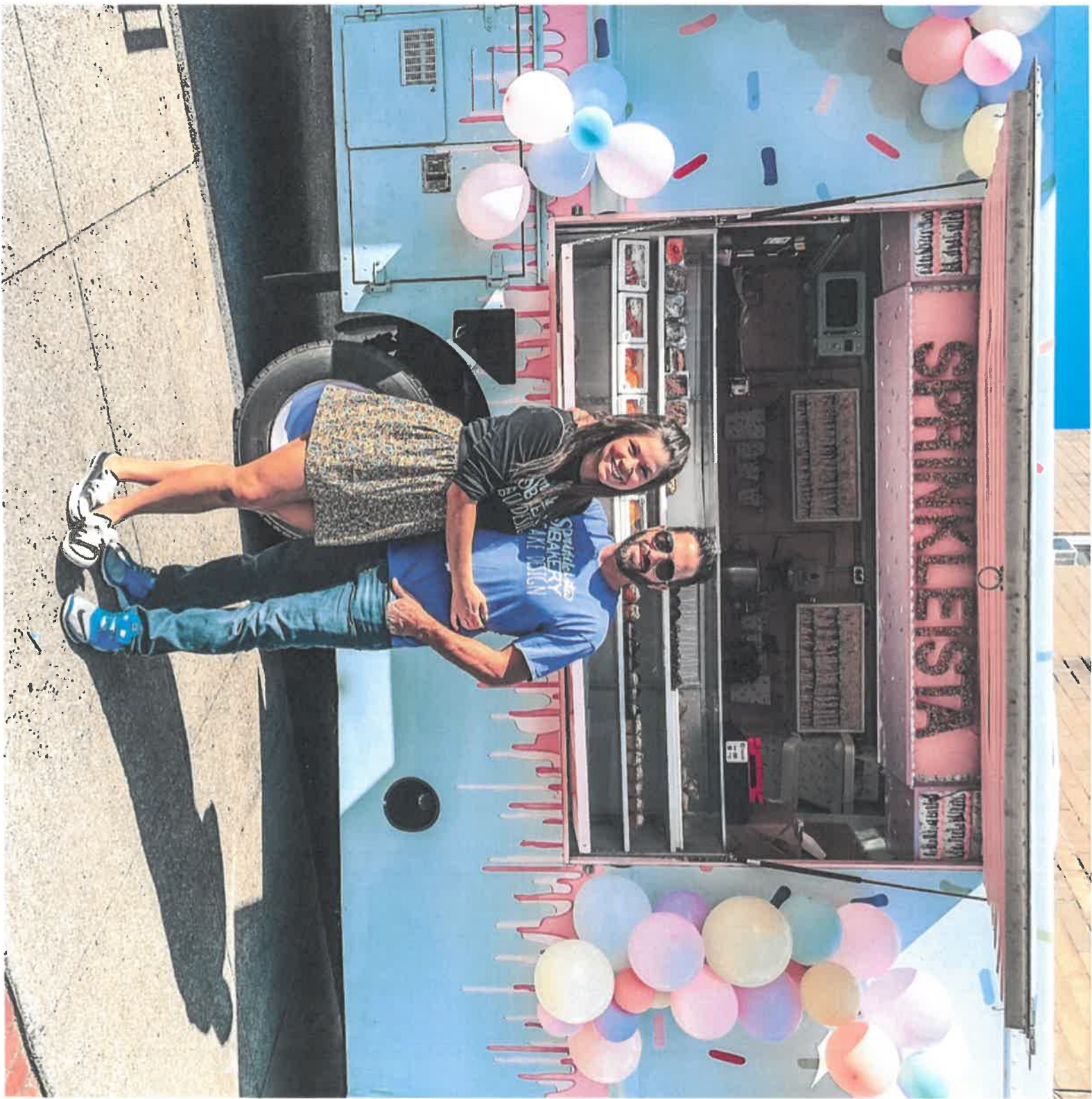

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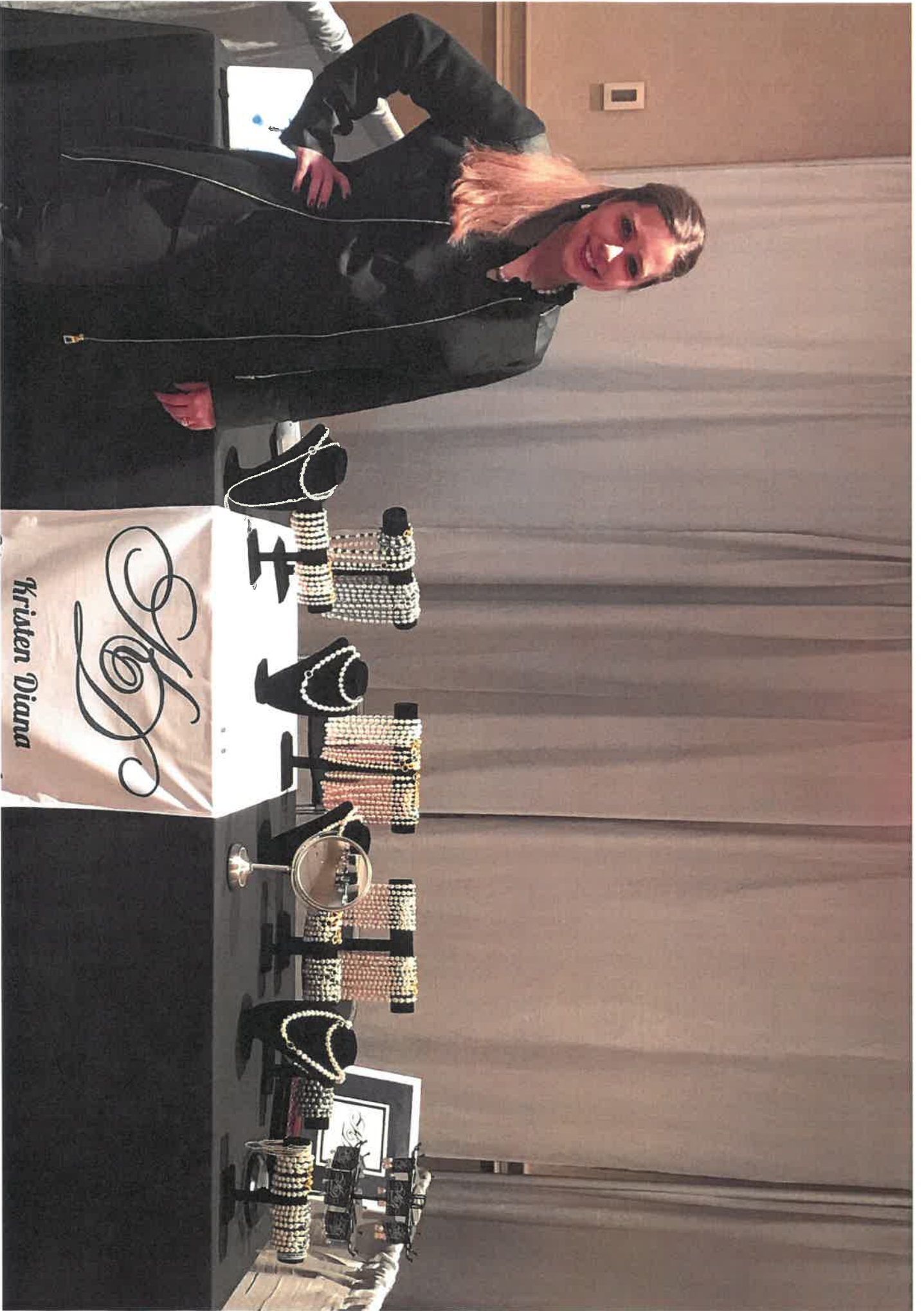
