Members discuss where to move the old files – possibly the Winter Garden Heritage Museum or a new Orange County building to be built in Ocoee.
- George discusses the Orange County plats left by Carl Patterson and will call Orange County to see if they want them. Theresa recommends calling the WG Heritage Museum.

3. Jackie has been cleaning up the landscaping around the schoolhouse and needs help. She would like 5 scouts to help with cleanup for one full day – weeding and pruning.
