We write today in support of H.R. 5062, a bill to designate the facility of the United States Postal Service located at 9930 Conroy Windermere Road in Windermere, Florida, as the "Officer Robert German Post Office Building."

On March 22, 2014, Officer Robert German of the Windermere Police Department was tragically killed in the line of duty at the age of 31. He was the first Windermere Police Officer to die in the line of duty in the 90 years since the founding of the town.

Officer German graduated from Lake Mary High School in 2001, and later attended South Georgia College. After college, he returned to Central Florida, and graduated from the Seminole State College Law Enforcement Academy in 2007. Following his graduation, Officer German pursued a career of public service with the Windermere Police Department, where he faithfully served his community for five years until his tragic murder in the line of duty.

In honor of his life and service to our nation, as well as his unwavering devotion to protect his community, we support the dedication of the United States Postal Service facility in Windermere to Officer Robert German. We are proud to offer support for this bill and appreciate your consideration of this legislation.
