For this, such person may need to ensure that a verbatim record of such proceeding is made which includes the testimony and evidence upon which the appeal is to be based.

- Schedules are created on a QUARTERLY basis (every three months). <u>Trucks can expect to be invited to an event zero to one event per quarter due to the high volume of trucks approved by the Town of Windermere Selection Committee.</u>

I would like to start this letter by introducing myself. I am George C. Morhack, Owner of *Carrington Creations*. *Carrington Creations* is in the business of designing and manufacturing custom apparel and non-apparel products. A more recent product is a "modified" Gaiter bandanna.

I asked about the process for submitting the application. He said to submit my information via Facebook. I told him that I "do not" have a Facebook account (for personal reasons). His next suggestion is for me to submit my application at the above address. Thus, this cover letter.

Product Description

The "modified" bandanna product uses a micro-fiber material. The design is permanently sublimated printed on one side. The product size is approximately 18.75" in diameter x 12" high with the edges being hem finished. The product has a tapered "V" front with a rear seam of approximately 4" long. This product is washable. There is one notice about washing the product. It is **do not use bleach**. Bleach will damage the design.

Tent Weight

In the attached photos, you will notice that there are no weights on any of the tent legs. I did not think that they were necessary due to the location (my back yard) and the fact that this was only a photo shoot. I do have 4 tent leg weights. They are approximately 30 lbs. each.
