Reviewed Pedestrian Bridge

Council and survey favored the bow bridge design option 4 (\$230k base price), painted brown or bronze. with 14' (inside dimension) width. Minimum height to be same as road bridge, will have concrete path, lighting will be incorporated, should be able to self-fund beginning of next year, also looking for funding elsewhere.

Stormwater Drainage (FIMA approved \$1m 75% for design and construction Town portion 25%) for the following projects:

W 2nd Ave in secondary design

1st/Forest preparing mediation plans

Butler/7th and Bessie will be awarded by TC in Feb. for design

Creating a swim area around bird island + adding a critical wildlife area. Will have to anchor out of swim areas. Still not allowed on island.

Also talking to District 1 Commissioner about getting round-a-bouts at 6th/Main (increased capacity), Chase/Main and Windermere/Maguire. Plan is to get people in and out of Windermere faster.

Ward Trail phasing reviewed.
