


Phase I Limits



- Deck brushed concrete




Recommendations from Arborist Report

- Root Protection Recommendations
 - Root Pruning or protection
 - Porous paving
 - Gravel base under trail
- Additional recommendations for tree removal
 - Poor structure
 - Poor conditions
 - Invasive species
- Recommended relocation of golf-cart connection to Lake Butler Blvd to avoid impacting Longleaf Pine



Design Plans: Minor Updates Since 60%



- Revised Alignment to avoid additional tree root impacts
- Relocated golf-cart connection to Lake Butler Blvd to avoid impacting Longleaf Pine




Example Location – View from Lake Butler Boulevard
