

5TH & FOREST ROAD IMPROVEMENTS

Public Input Meeting December 6, 2022

BACKGROUND

- In September, a Waste Pro truck broke an axle and spilled diesel. This required repairs to Park Avenue Roundabout and Lake Butler.
- The vendor provided costs for the repairs that mirrored prices from 2019. Those two projects were approved by Town Council and will be paid for by Waste Pro.
- Since mobilization is the majority of the cost, staff looked at other areas where there was a need or an area to explore for potential improvements.
- With the amount of traffic, parking lot proximity, pedestrian traffic, handicap accessibility and the construction of the new pavilion, staff is now exploring the opportunity to do some selective paving in a minimal defined area of 5th and Forest.

BACKGROUND

- As with any potential paving project, Town Council needs to approve the project.
- Town Council requested input from the public prior to taking any action
- This is a small defined area and there are no plans to pave any other locations that have not been already approved.
- Project cost: \$57,007.67
