Town Council Workshop Lake Street Park and Temporary Restrooms Town Square

July 24, 2024

PRESENT:

Present were Mayor Jim O'Brien, Council Members Andy Williams, Mandy David, Tony Davit, and Brandi Haines. Also present were Town Manager Robert Smith, Public Works Director Tonya Elliott-Moore, and Town Clerk Dorothy Burkhalter. Mr. John Fitzgibbon was also present. Member Tom Stroup was absent.

1. WORKSHOP CALLED TO ORDER

Mayor O'Brien opened the workshop at 6:07pm.

2. DISCUSSION ITEMS:

a. Lake Street Park Access System and Fencing

Mayor O'Brien introduced this item. He then turned the floor over to Director Elliott-Moore. Director Elliott-Moore reviewed past meetings and discussions that led up to this workshop. She commented on the high-water mark, fencing locations (current and proposed), pedestrian gate, and materials and costs. Mayor O'Brien commented on the need for delineation for private property and golf cart parking. Member David commented on the need for a loading/unloading zone. After minimal discussion was made regarding timing for completion and public access, Mayor O'Brien stated that this item will be on the next Town Council agenda.

b. Temporary Restroom Facilities at Town Square Park

Mayor O'Brien turned the floor over to Director Elliott-Moore. Director Elliott-Moore commented on past discussion regarding a restroom trailer for the Town Hall square due to the previous bathrooms being demolished and recent requests. She stated that at the request of Member Haines, the prefab restrooms were researched. Director Elliott-Moore explained that in the research, there is a possibility of piggybacking with another municipality for the prefab facilities. She commented on the costs with the prefab. Director Elliott-Moore also commented on a few other options. Discussion followed regarding timeline for Town Hall restrooms, purchase vs renting, purchase for future events, other designs/styles/varieties, focus on long term and expense, and locations. Mayor O'Brien commented that the conversation summed up as focusing on the town hall and expenses.
