



CAMPAIGN FUND-RAISER

A “campaign fund-raiser” is a breakfast, dinner, luncheon, rally, party, reception or other affair held to raise funds to be used in a campaign for public office.

Raising Campaign Funds

No campaign fund-raiser may be held until the person for whom the funds are being raised is a Candidate. (Must have filed the Appointment of Campaign Treasurer and Designation of Campaign Depository)

Contributions to Campaign Fund-Raisers

All money and contributions made with respect to a campaign fund-raiser are campaign contributions and must be deposited into the Campaign Account of the Candidate. All such contributions are subject to the contribution limits and are to be accounted for and reported as any other contribution.

Expenditures for Campaign Fund-Raisers

All expenditures with respect to a campaign fund-raiser are to be made by a check drawn on the Campaign Account of the Candidate and are deemed to be Campaign Expenditures, accounted for and subject to the same restrictions as other Campaign Expenditures .

Tickets and Advertising for Campaign Fund-Raisers

Any tickets or advertising for a campaign fund-raiser must contain the disclaimers and other information required of political advertising. In addition, all tickets and advertising for such campaign fund-raiser must contain the following statement: “The purchase of a ticket for, or a contribution to, the campaign fund-raiser is a contribution to the campaign of “Name of Candidate for whose benefit to campaign fund raiser is held).”
